



### Strains

1. An officer strained his shoulder by carrying a subject out of a building.
2. A police officer strained his back while removing his body armor.

### Strains from Motor Vehicle Collisions

1. An officer experienced pain and tingling in his left shoulder and side after a vehicle disregarded a traffic signal and collided with a police vehicle.
2. An officer received neck and knee injuries after a vehicle struck a police vehicle that was en route to a service call.

### Strains from Foot Pursuits

1. A police officer received a forearm injury after tackling a subject during a foot pursuit.
2. A police officer suffered a knee injury after tackling a subject involved in a foot pursuit.
3. A police officer received a big toe injury when forced to take a suspect to the ground during a chase.

### Slips / Falls

1. A police officer walking down a set of stairs fell down the last three steps, injuring her ankle.
2. A police officer injured his arm and toe while moving a pole out of the road. The officer fell when the pole suddenly moved.
3. A police officer responding to a robbery call stepped in a hole while approaching the residence, injuring his ankle.

### Exposures

#### From Animal Bites:

1. A police officer arresting a subject from a traffic stop requested that his coworker release a K9 inside the vehicle. The K9 bit the officer's shin and thigh when the officer attempted to retrieve the animal from the vehicle.
2. A dog bit an officer who was responding to a call of a vicious pit bull who had broken his leash when the officer secured a K9. The dog bit the officer in the upper thigh.

#### From Narcotics:

1. A police officer processing suspected ecstasy inhaled narcotics when some of the dust went into the air.
2. A police officer was exposed to suspected fentanyl during an arrest.

### Arrests

1. A subject resisted arrest, causing the subject and officer to fall to the ground. The officer was hit in the back of the arm and finger during the fall.
2. A subject head-butted an officer in the face during a struggle, causing an eye injury.
3. An officer received a strained wrist when a subject pulled away during an arrest.
4. An officer suffered pain, swelling, and bruising to the wrist after helping EMS restrain a combative patient.
5. A subject fighting with an officer during an arrest struck the officer in the face.
6. An escapee from the sheriff's department resisted being cuffed, causing the police officer pain in his shoulder.
7. A subject resisted being cuffed by a police officer, causing an injury to the officer's shoulder.

### Training

1. A police officer felt lightheaded and had discomfort in his chest while conducting SWAT training.
2. A dog bit a handler in the web of her fingers during K9 narcotics training.
3. A K9 bit an officer outfitted in a bite suit in the hand during K9 training.
4. A police officer completing an obstacle course for training strained his shoulder while negotiating through the monkey bars.
