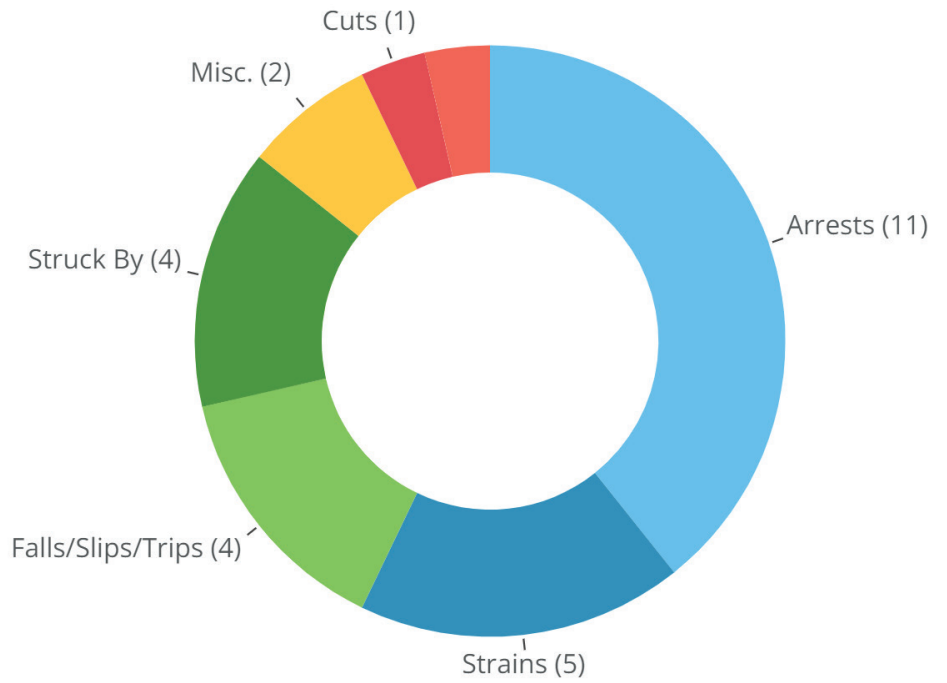
## JULY 2024

### LAW ENFORCEMENT WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAIMS

- 07/01/24 Cannine attack to R arm, L arm, and L leg placing canine back in the van after utilizing at a traffic stop.
- 07/01/24 Foot pursuit, stepped in hole, twisted R knee.
- 07/03/24 Bump to left knee on trailer hitch of vehicle.
- 07/12/24 Arrest, laceration to L thumb dealing with intoxicated suspect taking to ground. Three bites to R hand and R armpit.
- 07/12/24 Foot pursuit, rolled L ankle, fell, landing on L knee.
- 07/13/24 Lowering barrier at gun range, barrier smashed L index finger.
- 07/14/24 Dog left in vehicle and owner removed the dog. Officer got close to speak to individual and dog launched and bit R hand. Puncture marks to R hand and ring finger.
- 07/15/24 Stepped in hole and rolled L ankle.
- 07/16/24 Spat in the face while attempting to restrain a female.
- 07/16/24 Spat in the face while attempting to restrain female suspect. Possible bodily fluid exposure.
- 07/16/24 At front yard of house dog came and bit R Leg.
- 07/16/24 Dispatched to a church and during arrest altercation injured R wrist, forearm, R knee, and lower back.
- 07/17/24 Employee was feeling ill at 14:30, could not breathe, felt weak, and taken to ER. Deceased at 16:37.
- 07/17/24 Experienced a medical issue with BP exiting restroom, entered hallway, fell resulting in injury to R ankle. R ankle fx.
- 07/18/24 Responding to lift assist of gentleman from floor, began experiencing pain in lower back.
- 07/19/24 Arrest altercation, injured both knees on concrete.
- 07/19/24 Pursuit of juvenile on motorcycle, got juvenile off, bike while resisting arrest. Injured knees on concrete, tore L hand fingernail halfway off bleeding.
- 07/19/24 Practicing different movements while at firing range, pulled L leg ligament.
- 07/20/24 On a call, tripped on crack in sidewalk, twisted R ankle.
- 07/23/24 L knee pain during run.
- 07/24/24 Minor scrape on R shin during arrest altercation.

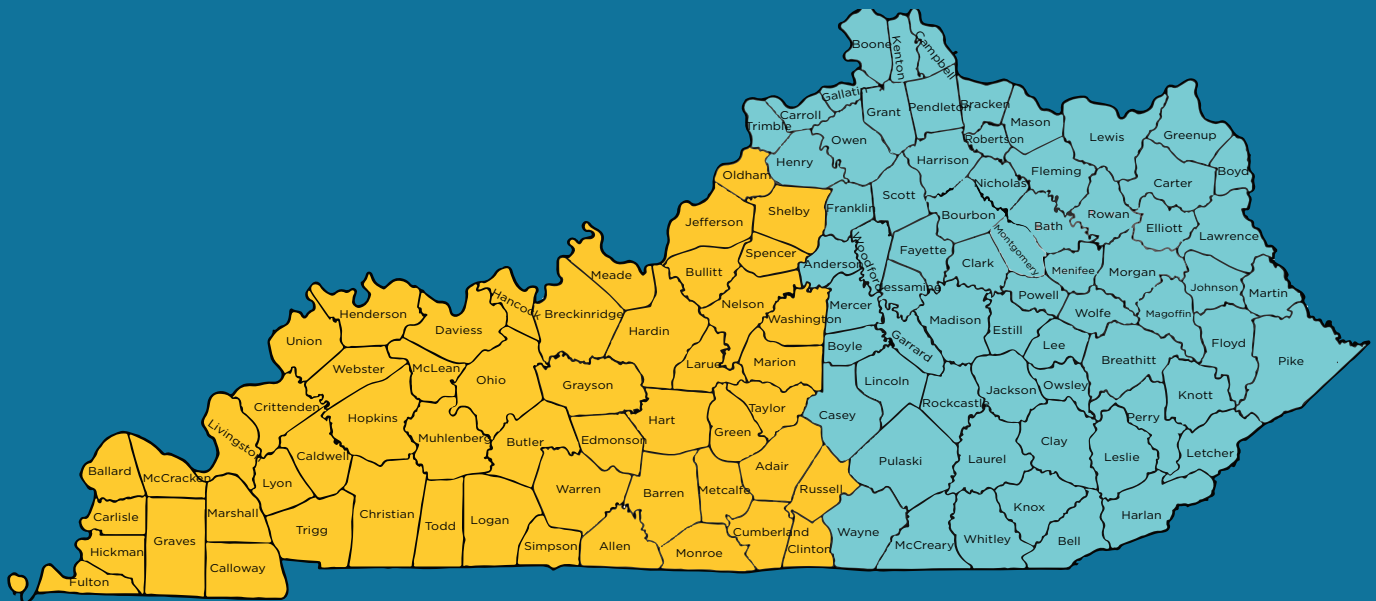
