



LIABILITY GRANT PROGRAM

Eligibility

- ◆ The applying city or agency must be a current member of the Kentucky League of Cities Insurance program with liability coverage.
- ◆ Only one application will be accepted from each insured member.

Important Safety Grant Program Dates

- ◆ The application period is **Sept. 16, 2024 – Nov. 8, 2024.**
- ◆ Invoices or purchase orders must be attached to the grant and returned at the same time.
- ◆ We will accept purchase orders and invoices dated July 1, 2024, to Nov. 8, 2024.
- ◆ Due to the popularity of this grant, we advise members to apply early. If liability grant applications exceed funds available, **grants will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.**
- ◆ All applications must be submitted online.

Application Rules

- ◆ **The Liability Grant is a 50/50 matching grant for approved purchases.**
- ◆ Members with liability premiums before taxes less than \$35,000 are eligible for up to \$1,500 grant reimbursements.
- ◆ Members with liability premiums before taxes of \$35,000 and above are eligible for up to \$3,000 grant reimbursements.

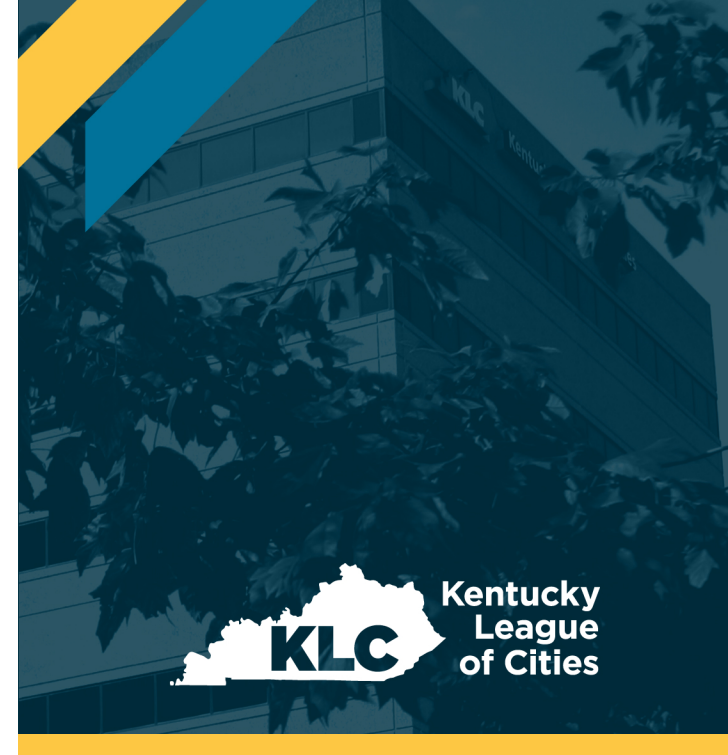

ELIGIBLE ITEMS LIST



■ Vehicles

- ◆ Defensive driver training
- ◆ Telematic systems used to enforce fleet safety and influence safe driving behaviors
- ◆ Costs associated with conducting pre-hire or annual motor vehicle record (MVR) checks
- ◆ Backup cameras and sensors

■ Personnel Services

- ◆ Employee handbooks and training provided by the KLC legal team (will accept invoices during calendar year 2024)

■ Cybersecurity Training

- ◆ Cybersecurity Training (online or in-person)

■ Mowers

- ◆ Mulching mowers or kits to prevent discharge accidents

■ Law Enforcement

(Must have KLC Insurance Law Enforcement coverage)

- ◆ KACP police accreditation fees (will accept invoices during calendar year 2024)
- ◆ Defensive driver training and telematic systems
- ◆ Body cameras (Storage and monthly fees are not included, and a model policy must be submitted with the application.)
- ◆ Gun safes
- ◆ Moving-target training systems

■ Parks/Playgrounds

- ◆ Any playground surfacing material listed under the Consumer Product Safety Committee Guidelines to protect against fall injuries
- ◆ New playground equipment to replace old equipment (picture required of old or damaged equipment)
- ◆ Certified Playground Safety Inspector Training

■ Slip-and-Fall Protection

- ◆ Sidewalk replacement or repair

■ Utilities

- ◆ Sewer backup prevention (must have sewer backup coverage with KLC Insurance)
- ◆ Cameras, rodding, and hydro blasting equipment
- ◆ Radio read meters (gas and water)
- ◆ Meter lids that meet liability review guidelines for KLC Insurance
- ◆ Hit kits for natural gas companies to document damaged lines (e.g., Rhino Hit Kit)
- ◆ Signage for electric utilities (e.g., high voltage, no trespassing)
- ◆ Trimming trees around electrical substations, utility perimeter fencing, and electrical transmission right-of-ways
