Total Claims

LAW ENFORCEMENT WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAIMS

- **9/3/2024** While answering a 911 complaint he was attacked by a pitbull. As he left the porch, he twisted his left ankle.
- 9/4/2024 Smashed right pinky finger in car door
- 9/6/2024 Bit or scratched by resisting subject. Broken skin and red marks on R upper arm.
- 9/12/2024 Possible TB exposure while in close quarters working on patient.
- 9/12/2024 Possible exposure to person with inactive TB.
- 9/14/2024 Called to collision involvng a semi carrying chemicals. Inhalation of chemicals.
- 9/14/2024 Exposed to fumes coming out of oil and diesel from the fire. Lightheaded, headache, and difficulty breathing.
- **9/14/2024** Responding to collision and was exposed to burning diesel, oil, and transmission fluid causing shortness of breath, lightheadedness, and a headache.
- **9/14/2024** Responding to a collision between two semis and was exposed to fumes causing headache and chest tightness.
- 9/15/2024 Involved in an altercation causing injury to R hand ring finger fx.
- 9/16/2024 Arrest altercation resulted in an abrasion to forehead, L knee, and both elbows.
- 9/17/2024 Dog bite to R Leg shin/knee from vicious dog running loose in neighborhood.
- 9/20/2024 Doing sprints, ran five miles and started having pain next day in L hamstring and knee.
- **9/22/2024** Held down dementia patient resisting assistance on the way to hospital causing lower back pain.
- **9/23/2024** Arrest altercation. When trying to place the suspect inside a vehicle was kicked and pinned R hand between door and suspect's foot. Pain to R hand and fingers.
- 9/25/2024 Doing bench press and felt sharp pain to R shoulder.
- **9/26/2024** Scraped skin off the ring and middle fingers of L hand. Scraped knuckles and bend of finger during arrest altercation.
- **9/28/2024** Employee tried to arrest suspect and twisted his right knee and slammed it into the ground.
- 9/28/2024 Left shoulder injury placing suspect in cruiser.
- **9/29/2024** The employee stated that while turning the company vehicle onto the interstate, another car t-boned the back passenger side. He has a headache and left-hand pain.
- **9/30/2024** Employee knocking on the front door when dog bit him in the right thigh.
- **10/1/2024** Resisting suspect bit officer's left upper arm.
- **10/1/2024** Employee pulled a muscle in his inner right thigh while escorting a suspect being arrested to the ground.


