- Whereas,** Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and
- Whereas,** Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information, and ensuring their safety; and
- Whereas,** Public Safety Telecommunicators of Madison County 911 have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients; and
